Our aim is to bridge the digital divide, and provide high speed, low cost internet for all New Yorkers. We see the telecom monopoly in the rapidly inflating cost of internet service, poor quality service, and hundreds of thousands of New Yorkers being left behind. By building our own network, we're able to provide better internet service at a much lower cost, while respecting your privacy. We're net-neutral, and don't throttle or block content. 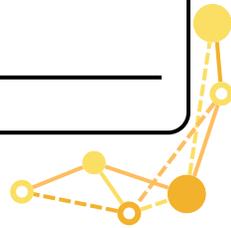

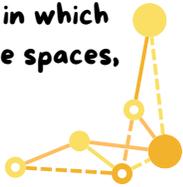

## Moving Out?

*It's very important that you let us know if you are planning to move out!*

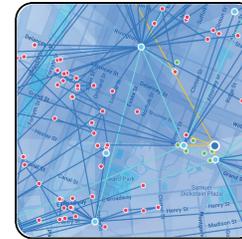
As NYC Mesh is a shared, distributed network,  
your building may be providing connection to your neighbors,  
who may lose their internet if your equipment is unplugged!



Please reach out to us as soon as you know you'll be moving  
so we can ensure your neighbors stay connected.

## How does the mesh work?

Members connect to NYC Mesh with a wireless antenna on their roof connected to a neighborhood hub or other building already on the network. These wireless links connect everyone to each other, and back to our data centers, where we connect to the open internet.

NYC Mesh Members typically have a dedicated home WiFi router that connects with a cable to the rooftop antenna and broadcasts their WiFi networks used in their home.
