We see the telecom monopoly in the rapidly inflating cost of internet service, poor quality service, and hundreds of thousands of New Yorkers being left behind. By reaching out to us, you can help us ensure that we correctly close your account and reset your equipment so that it's ready for the next family that moves in.




How does the mesh work?

NYC Mesh has worked with your building to provide internet access for you and your neighbors. Your building is connected with an antenna on the roof to the Mesh network, which connects buildings to each other forming a network across the city. In data centers around the city, we connect to the Internet so Mesh members can browse the web, stream movies or TV and access online services.

Our volunteers have installed a wall mounted access point in your apartment, which broadcasts a WiFi network ready for you to use when you move in!

Security of the Mesh

We take every precaution to keep our members and their information safe. Most web applications encrypt traffic on the internet by default, lowering the risk of your private information being exposed.
