By reaching out to us, you can help us ensure that we correctly close your account and can provide instructions on how to reset your equipment so that it's ready for the next family that moves in.

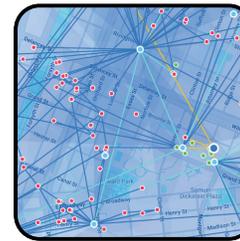


## How does the mesh work?

Your building is connected to NYC Mesh with fiber to the home (FTTH)  
NYC Mesh has leased a fiber cable from our data center which runs under the street to your building and then to your apartment.

A WiFi router in your apartment (called an ONU) is connected to the fiber and broadcasts a WiFi network for you to use.

Your building's fiber network provides a high quality internet connection for your devices, while also being an important part of the Mesh, sharing this high speed connection with the rest of the network.



The WiFi ONU installed in your apartment usually looks like this.
